BMW'S JOINT VENTURE CRITICAL TECHWORKS IS EXPANDING FAST IN PORTUGAL



Critical TechWorks is in charge of BMW's autonomous driving. Space modelling, road mapping and automatic braking are some of the projects under development in Lisbon and Porto.

With more than two years of activity and more than 54 projects delivered to the German manufacturer, of which stands out the Operating System 7 and the new applications for BMW and MINI, Critical TechWorks is now looking for junior and senior profiles to join these teams who are aligned with the company's values.

The company has attracted about 1000 employees in these two and a half years of operation and, according to the new projects already identified, the goal, by the end of 2021, is to hire another 400 employees, reaching 1400 people.

RACING TO MARS WITH A TOUCH OF PORTUGUESE ENGINEERING
