



CS WIND TO FURTHER EXPAND OPERATION IN PORTUGAL

Currently with a team of 500 employees, the company wants to double its Portuguese workforce to reach 1,000 people and quintuple its subsidiary's turnover to 400 million euros in 2025.



RYANAIR TO HIRE 100 TECH PROFESSIONALS IN PORTUGAL

Ryanair Labs, the technology arm within the Irish airline Ryanair Group, has announced the recruitment target of 100 tech professionals to join its fully remote working Portuguese tech hub. Roles vary across software development, business intelligence, quality assurance, security and project management.



STELLANTIS STARTS EV PRODUCTION IN PORTUGAL

The Mangualde Production Center will become the first assembly plant in Portugal to produce large series fully battery electric compact vans for Citroën, Fiat, Opel and Peugeot by 2025. Besides updating its facilities and production processes, the Mangualde plant also completed the second phase of its solar energy park, which will provide up to 31% of the plant's annual electricity needs.
