# **EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT MEASURES**

The Government reinforced two existing employment incentive measures and renamed the initiative as ATIVAR.PT

Under the ATIVAR.PT initiative, the new internships and financial grants reflect an increase in the financial support for employees and employers. The 9-months internship program has increased the monthly grant per intern, which is now 706.23 EUR for a university graduate. The financial grant ATIVAR.PT is increased by 33%, which means an amount of 5,265.72 EUR for a permanent employment contract and 1,755.24 EUR for a fixed-term one..

# Portugal ranks #1 in bicycle production in EU

According to Eurostat, Portugal assembled 2.7 million bicycles, followed by Italy (2.1 million), Germany (1.5 million), Poland (0.9 million) and the Netherlands (0.7 million). These top five bicycle-manufacturing countries accounted for 70% of total EU production in 2019. Europe's bike boom is nothing but good news to the country's outstanding development of the sector in recent years.
