Over the last 5 years, Portugal registered the 3rd highest growth rate in number of FDI projects - a whopping 40% - strengthening its position at the Top 10 preferred locations for investors.

REVOLUT INAUGURATES OFFICE IN LISBON




Four years after settling in Porto region (Matosinhos), the British digital bank Revolut has opened a second location for its innovation and support centre in Lisbon, where around 250 of its 1,300 employees in Portugal are based. Despite the new office, Revolut will maintain its fully remote and flexible work policy and the move to Portugal's capital is driven by employee growth in the area.

LISBON: A GLOBAL SUBSEA CABLE HUB





Lisbon is emerging as a crucial hub for subsea cable networks due to its strategic location connecting Europe, Africa, the Mediterranean, and the Atlantic. This enhances global digital infrastructure and resilience by providing new routes to emerging markets but also alternative routes between developed markets.

Recent investments include the Equiano and 2Africa cables aimed at increasing Africa's digital connectivity, and the EllaLink cable which reduces latency between Europe and Latin America. Additionally, the upcoming Medusa and Nuvem cables will further enhance connectivity between Europe, North Africa, the Mediterranean, the Atlantic, and the U.S.

Mitsubishi Fuso Truck Europe S.A. (MFTE), headquartered in Tramagal, Portugal, is celebrating its 60th anniversary. As a significant employer in the region, MFTE reached a production record in 2023 with about 11,800 trucks, including the light-duty Canter and electric eCanter. The plant, an example in sustainable production, has achieved CO2 neutrality in 2022 and is reducing water usage.

Portugal's top 10 exporters in 2023 include 7 foreign automotive companies: Volkswagen, Continental, Bosch, Aptiv, Visteon, Forvia and Eberspächer. Galp (energy), the Navigator Company (pulp and paper) and Lilly Pharmaceuticals complete the top 10. These exporters accounted for 17.4% of national exports.


