September 2024



Portugal is considered the 7th most attractive country in Europe, with 221 foreign projects in 2023. Some key highlights:

- Software & IT and Business Services remain the top sectors representing almost 60% of total FDI projects.
- 8 out of 10 investors surveyed intend to establish or expand operations in Portugal.
- Skills and availability of talent, level of technology adoption and quality of life, diversity and culture are the main drivers of attractiveness.
- The country remains a leader in sustainability with one of the highest percentages in renewables, with a and strong focus on CleanTech and decarbonization.

OGMA launches maintenance line for Pratt & Whitney



OGMA has opened a new engine maintenance line for Pratt & Whitney geared turbofan engines, aiming to triple revenues at full capacity. This €90 million investment expects to create 200 jobs. Besides its new GTF capability, OGMA, owned 65% by Embraer and 35% by the Portuguese Government, also works on Rolls-Royce T56, AE2100, AE3007, and AE1107 engines, offering MRO services for commercial, defense, and executive jets, including airframe, components, painting, manufacturing, and engineering.

Iberdrola increases renewable production in Portugal



The Montechoro I and II PV plants in the Algarve, completed with a total capacity of 37 MW and annual production of 56.84 GWh, now boost Portugal's renewable energy capacity. Awarded to Iberdrola in a 2019 auction, these plants will supply energy to 19,000 households and prevent over 21,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions annually. With a total investment of €30 million, the installation of these plants created about 200 jobs.

A recent ITU - International Telecommunication Union report revealed that Portugal is among the world's leading nations in cybersecurity. In its 2024 Global Cybersecurity Index (GCI), Portugal has reached a significant milestone, advancing to 4th place globally, alongside Singapore and the USA, and achieving the top classification: Tier 1 -Role-modelling. This represents a remarkable improvement from 8th place in the European region in 2020. Such prestigious international recognition underscores Portugal's leadership and commitment to enhancing global cybersecurity.

REN and Siemens Energy partnership in electric mobility

Sifted 50: Southern Europe - The fastest-growing startups in 2024

Portugal is home to 6 companies in the Sifted 50 Southern Europe - The fastestgrowing startups in 2024, only behind Italy and Spain. Three Portuguese startups - Coverflex, Equalfood, and Bridge In - are in the top 15. Other companies on the list include Knokcare, Casafari, and HiJiffy. Portugal has reinvented itself as a leading tech hub, attracting young digital nomads and hosting the Web Summit since 2016.

Renewables supply 75% of electricity consumption in the first 8 months of 2024

From January to August 2024, 75% of Portugal's electricity consumption was sourced from renewables, with hydro accounting for 33%, wind for 26%, solar for 10%, and biomass for 6%. Natural gas covered 8%, while the remaining 17% was imported.
